Position **National Electronic Payment Systems (NEPS) Operation Support Officer**

Background:

The Central Bank, as part of the overall payments system reform, is implementing an Electronic Payments Switch to enable interbank routing of transactions including ATMs cash withdrawals, purchase using POS terminals, bills payment, mobile interoperability and other payment services in the country. The initial phase of the implementation is now operational with four commercial banks connected enabling their customers to withdraw cash from ATMs.

The CBL invites application from a technical expert to work with its internal team to execute the remaining phases of the project and manage all the stakeholders in the process. Such a person must have a sound grip of the switching domain and good exposure to the technology.
