Advertisement for Recruitment of External Members on the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of the Central Bank of Liberia

Position:	External Members of the MPC.
Number Needed:	Two (2)
Duration:	Two (2) years, initially

Background/Purpose:

In fulfillment of Part IV, Section 17, Count 1 of the Amended and Restated Central Bank of Liberia (CBL) Act of October 2020, applications are invited from suitably qualified individuals from within the private sector and academic community to serve as members of the CBL Monetary Policy Committee (MPC). The successful applicants will serve for a period of two years.

The MPC shall meet at least four (4) times in a year with the responsibility of making monetary policy decision by approving an official policy rate in relation to liquidity management to stabilize exchange rate and maintain domestic price stability for the overall growth and development of the economy.

Qualification

The members of the MPC shall be individuals of good standing, integrity, and unimpeachable character with a minimum of master's degree in Economics, Banking, or Finance, or related disciplines and at least 10 most

recent years of professional experience in monetary policy operations, banking supervision or macroeconomic analysis.

The members shall not be officially associated with the three branches of government, a political party or a financial institution (as employee) or owners of an equity interest in any of the domestic financial institutions.

Responsibility of the External Members:

The MPC Members will be responsible to review all documents prepared by the Secretariat. Members are required to deliberate and make comments on the macroeconomic situation and policy options based on the presentations made by the MPC Secretariat. Each member will state his/her view(s) on the recommendations of the MPC Secretariat to inform the decision voted upon by member (s) of the MPC, along with the reason (s) for taking such decision(s).

Application Requirements
